- To meet legal and contractual obligations with schools.

4. Data Sharing

We will only share information:

- With schools, parents, or relevant agencies for safeguarding purposes.
- Where required by law.
- With consent where appropriate.



5. Data Retention

Personal data is retained only for as long as necessary and then securely destroyed.

6. Rights of Individuals
